Meet Hannah*

Hannah is 14 and has a complicated family life. She lives alone with her grandmother. Her 10 siblings are either in care or with distant relatives, so she rarely sees them. She is a bright spark, but can't help but self-sabotage. When she first arrived at Go Beyond, she couldn't stop winding up the other young people on the break. She was her own worst enemy and struggled to make friends.

When she was on the minibus on a day trip, one of Hannah's favourite songs came on the radio and she asked the break leaders if they could turn it up loud. The bus filled with Whitney Houston's vocals followed by this small voice that grew and grew as the song went on. Hannah was belting it out! Hannah said that singing was her passion and that's what she wanted to do when she grew up. Everyone on the bus agreed that she was brilliant.

This really broke the ice and Hannah started to bond with the group. That night, everyone voted to do karaoke in the lounge. After singing Dolly Parton, Hannah asked the break leaders if they could all sing something as a group, and two minutes later the lounge was filled with young voices singing "You've got a friend in me" from Toy Story. By getting everyone singing together, Hannah bonded with the rest of the group and made friends for life.

When Hannah was getting ready to leave on the last day she said that she had found loads of new confidence and that, through her singing, she could reach out to people in a new way. She wanted to focus on positive things like this rather than self-sabotaging.

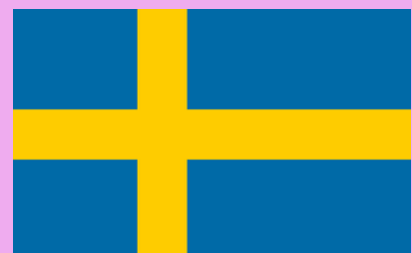
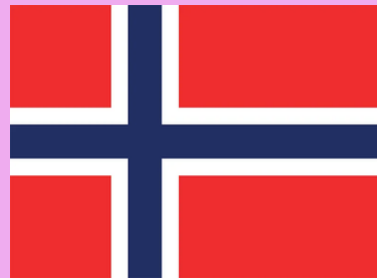

Serving you Swedish Meatball Realness



Get your taste buds tingling with these delicious Swedish Subs

Prep time: 30 mins Cook time: 20 mins
Makes 16 meatballs for 8 subs

STEP 1

- Mix all the meatball ingredients together with plenty of seasoning, then shape into walnut-sized balls. Freeze for 30 mins to firm up if the party is about to start, or chill in the fridge for up to 24 hrs.

STEP 2

- Heat oven to 220C/200C fan/gas 7. Roll the meatballs in the oil in a baking tray, then roast for 20 mins until browned and cooked through.

STEP 3

- When the meatballs are nearly ready, mix the vinegar and sugar in a mixing bowl to dissolve, then stir in the cucumber.

STEP 4

- Split the baguette chunks, rolls or subs and spread with a little cranberry sauce. Add some cucumber and 2-3 meatballs, arrange on a platter and serve.

Ingredients

- 1-2 tbsp sunflower oil, for frying
- 2 tbsp white wine vinegar
- 1 tbsp golden caster sugar
- 1/3 cucumber, thinly sliced
- 4 sub rolls, halved
- jar cranberry sauce

For the meatballs

- 300g pack pork mince
- 50g breadcrumb
- 1 tsp caraway or fennel seeds
- 1 egg, beaten
- 3 tbsp wholegrain mustard
- 1 tbsp clear honey
